3. There are always times when we get out of the habit of being regular at our gatherings. What are some of the dangers of this?
4. What practical steps can you take to help you and others make a priority of gathering together on Sundays?
5. When this week could you set aside some time to pray and prepare your heart for our Sunday gathering?
6. Who could you invite to join you next week?
