The Heart Of The Matter

We often use theological terms, but can sometimes misunderstand what they mean.

What does it mean for a Christian to be 'Justified'?

(For the person guiding the discussion - Justification is the opposite of condemnation. It is a legal term. It is achieved by the cross. It is a gift of grace not works. Like Abraham, If you've believed in God, then that's been credited to you as righteousness, and the Righteousness of Christ becomes your righteousness, and you are found in Him. No longer condemned by your own sin and rebellion, but legally not guilty.)
