The Spirit: Revealed – 1. Convicts of Sin

And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit

The Spirit: Revealed – 10. Sanctifies (fruit)
